1. Proper Noun ⇒ A proper noun is a name of the particular person, place, organization or thing.  
Example ⇒ Jackson, Disneyland, Saturday, Google etc.

(ii) Common Noun ⇒ A common noun is a name of common person, place or a thing is known as common noun.  
Example ⇒ Father, daughter, dog, goat, girl, hotel, swim, house, player, and pen etc.

(iii) Abstract Noun ⇒ An abstract noun is a word which names something that you cannot see, hear, touch etc.  
Example ⇒ We have to get at the truth of the matter.

(iv) Collective Noun ⇒ A group of person, place or things is called collective noun.  
As ⇒ Party, Team, Class, school etc.

(v) Material Noun ⇒ The substance, liquid, gases are material noun which gives us either energy or other form.  
As ⇒ Gold, oil, oxygen, silver, wood, petrol etc.

(vi) Concrete noun ⇒ which noun can be touch or seen and its is belong to solid things.

As  $\Rightarrow$  Table, Chair, fan, cooler, Cement, Bricks etc.

(vii) Countable noun  $\Rightarrow$  Which noun can be counted easily it is called countable noun.

As  $\Rightarrow$  Book, Pen, Chair, Boy, Girl.

(viii) Uncountable noun  $\Rightarrow$  Which noun can not be counted easily are called uncountable noun.

As  $\Rightarrow$  Dust, water, sand, rice, light etc.

(ix) Compound noun  $\Rightarrow$  Which noun can be created by two or more nouns that is called compound noun.

As  $\Rightarrow$   $\frac{\text{Foot}}{N} + \frac{\text{ball}}{N} \Rightarrow \text{Football}$ .
